1. The event

- 1.1. Event is held in order to promote ice-sailing in Baltics.
- 1.2. Lithuanian-Latvian Ice-Blokart Championships will be held on Curonian lagoon at Ventė cape, Lithuania.

3. Requirements for participants:

- 3.1. Championship is open, all sailors are allowed to participate
- 3.2. A competitor shall compete in compliance with recognized principles of sportsmanship and fair play.
- 3.3. Only production class Ice-Blokarts as described in IBRA rules and with standard BIL manufacture ice-blades are allowed to participate in this event.

4. Divisions:

- 4.1 participants are split into two weight Divisions:
Lightweight - participants lighter than 85 kg
Heavyweight - participants heavier than 85 kg
- 4.2 By the decision of Race office sub-divisions will be formed
- 4.3 By the decision of Race office other than stated in 4.1 weight divisions could be formed

5. Championship results

- 5.1 Bonus point scoring system is applied.
- 5.2 If the weight division is divided into sub-divisions, best sailors from each sub-division are competing in final races.
- 5.3 Winners in each weight division are awarded with championship prizes.
- 5.4 Individuals or Organizations can establish additional prizes. Race office must be informed about additional prizes before opening of the championship.

- 7. Entry fee:**
 - 7.1. Every participant must pay 30 Lt entry fee.
 - 7.2. Ice-Blokart rent fee for the participants not having their own equipment is 70 Lt for all races.

- 8. Organizing Authority:**
 - 8.1. Championship is organized by VšĮ „Irklakojis“ and Lithuanian Blokart Team.
 - 8.2. Championship organizers are not responsible for the safety of participants and equipment. Every participant should take care off their personal and material safety.
